**We are pleased to announce the 2026 Electrical Industry Scholarship Competition. Scholarship awards include two scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 per year for up to four years of undergraduate study, and two scholarships in the amount of \$1000 for the fall 2026 semester (a one-time award).**

To be eligible, applicants must be children of IBEW Local 134 members who are in good standing and working under the Principal Agreement, Communication Agreement or Residential Agreement. Children of deceased members may also be eligible to apply. Applicants must be high school seniors who will graduate in May or June 2026, or high school graduates who are registered in a college or university field of study directly related to the electrical construction industry. An independent Selection Committee comprised of members of academia will make the award selections.
