September 14, 2022 Speakers

Bob Reiter is the President of the Chicago Federation of Labor, the third largest central labor council of the national AFL-CIO. He previously served two terms as Secretary-Treasurer of the CFL from July 2010 to May 2018.

Bob holds a bachelor's and master's degree in political science from Eastern Illinois University and a Juris Doctor degree from IIT Chicago-Kent College of Law.

He praised Local 134 for our activism. He spoke of the Workers' Rights Amendment that will be on the ballot and how it was a vote for us. The so called right to work laws undermine the ability to bargain. Wisconsin a right to work state has destroyed bargaining. The Workers' Rights Amendment will affect all workers union or nonunion in Illinois positively.

Bob told of the southern states getting more federal tax dollars because of their low wages. We have a consumer-based economy and decent wages are needed to improve the economy. Though this amendment is for Illinois alone if passed it will influence and improve workers' rights throughout the country. He thanked us for being a great local and reminded us to remember to vote. Business Manager Don Finn was able to join our meeting and to pass out Honoree's photos. He spoke of the new medical clinic at the apprentice school and how in the future Local #134 will have a facility on the north side of the county. Premise Health Care will be there with Local #134 doing the hiring. Don said our future will be 60 years of age to retire. He said he's concerned at getting our C cards a health care package that had previously been given up.
