From the Podium

High temperatures kill hundreds of people every year. Heat-related deaths and illness are preventable, yet more than 700 people die from extreme heat every year in the United States.

Take measures to stay cool, remain hydrated, and keep informed. Getting too hot can make you sick. You can become ill from the heat if your body can't compensate for it and properly cool you off.

Those who are at highest risk include people 65 and older, children younger than two, and people with chronic diseases or mental illness.

- Stay in air-conditioned buildings as much as you can.
- Drink more water than usual and don't wait until you're thirsty to drink.
- Check on a friend or neighbor and have someone do the same for you.
- Don't use the stove or oven to cook—it will make you and your house hotter.
- Limit your outdoor activity, especially midday when the sun is hottest.

Our speaker today was Patrick S Sullivan from the Frankfort Law Group. He spoke to us about estate planning, focusing on wills and trusts. Wills can end up in probate and can take several months and some expense before heirs can collect. Living Trusts can eliminate probate. He explained how to designate the power of attorney to make medical decisions as well as financial and property decisions for us, when we can't. Illinois has a Healthcare Surgery Act allowing you to choose who will make a life or death decisions when you can't.
